Program Assistant: Registered Behavior Technician (RBT)

A Program Assistant is a professional who practices under the supervision of a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA). The Program Assistant's primary responsibility is the direct implementation of treatment plans designed to help individuals with autism develop social skills, reduce challenging behavior, and learn new skills. They are also responsible for electronically collecting data during each therapy session, and communicating with clinical teams. All Program Assistants are required to obtain the Registered Behavior Technician (RBT) credential within 90 days of employment after on-site classroom and hands on training.

Required skills

- Bachelor's Degree (or pursuing) preferred but not required
- Three references for employment verification
- Experience working with children with special needs preferred
- Ability to build and maintain relationships with children
- Ability and desire to work patiently and compassionately with children who have challenging behaviors
- Frequent kneeling, stooping, bending, stair climbing, and sitting on the floor to attend to children's needs; this position is rated as active and regularly requires the individual to lift 30-50 pounds and move quickly
- Ability to work independently as well as collaboratively with a team
- Strong organizational, time management, and multi-tasking skills
- Clearance of a state and federal criminal background check

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
